Requirements:

- Be a high school student graduating in the current academic year.
- Applicants must be permanent residents of Ontario in the geographic boundaries that encompass the District of Parry Sound and the District of Muskoka.
- Be graduating high school in 2026 and be attending post-secondary in 2026/2027 (college, trades school, or university).
